The finalists are eligible to compete in the "Technology Fast 500," also sponsored by Deloitte & Touche which ranks the nation's top 500 fastest growing technology companies. Technology companies in business a minimum of three years were eligible for the Rising Star Award.

Winners of the 21 regional Fast 50 programs in the United States are automatically entered in the Deloitte & Touche Technology Fast 500 program.
